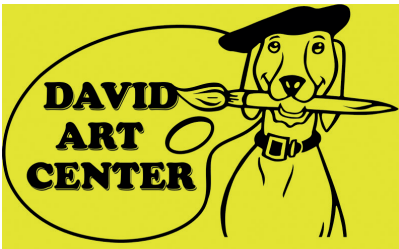

History

The New Orleans Art Association is a non-profit 501(c)(3) organization open to artists or art lovers over the age of 18. Our goals are to promote art and recognize artists in the community by exhibiting and publicizing our work throughout the New Orleans area. The Association consists of professional artists, weekend painters, business people, students, and art lovers who work to make it an important educational tool for ourselves and the community. Our members find that meeting for study, discussion and juried exhibitions enhances our cultural growth.

The Art Association of New Orleans dates to 1887. By 1907, our annual exhibition attracted artists whose works are now coveted by prominent museums and collectors. Claude Monet, Childe Hassam, Winslow Homer, Mary Cassatt, George Luks, Robert Henri and other prominent artists entered these competitions.

When the Delgado Museum opened in 1911, the Art Association was instrumental in not only acquiring fine works for the collections, but also holding exhibitions. Isaac Delgado created the Artists' Biennial, which was continued by the Museum (now called the New Orleans Museum of Art) until 1977.

An art group known as the Art Association Guild was founded on October 13, 1952, to support the work of its parent group, the Art Association of New Orleans, which is now known as the New Orleans Art Association.

The New Orleans Art Association has held 23 national or international art exhibitions.

NOAA Aims and Objectives

Encourage and develop a more vital interest and understanding of art. Provide members with exhibitions, lectures, juried art shows, demonstrations, art films, workshops, and private tours.

Assist members and local artists by exhibiting and publicizing their work in a professional manner, thus encouraging sales. Present cash prizes in competitive shows.

Acquire a collection of paintings intended as an eventual gift to the people of the Greater New Orleans area. These works of art will be on loan to the public schools and buildings in the community.

Offer scholarships to talented and serious students.

Then known as the Art Association of New Orleans, it presented both national and international shows.
