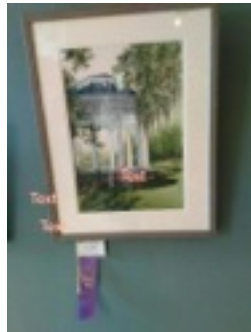
I hope to see you at the Get Crockin' event, and wish you all a wonderful, art-filled Summer!

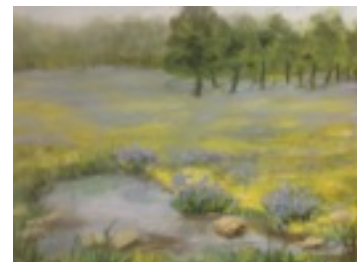
