

The New Orleans Art Association's Historic Pirate's Alley Art Show and Festival will include a quick-draw paint out this year.

On Friday, March 27, 2020, in anticipation of eventually hosting a plein air event, NOAA has arranged a quick-draw competition. Acclaimed plein air painter Phil Sandusky will be our judge. Sign in will be from 8:15-9:15 Friday morning, at the corner of Père Antoine Alley and Chartres Street (at Jackson Square). Pre-registered participants should bring their paper or canvas to be stamped in preparation for the quick-draw. Artists will receive directions and instructions, along with a lunch voucher. Volunteers will escort participating artists to the area we will be painting, and the bell to begin work will be rung at 10:00 a.m. The stop time is 12:00 noon, and the bell will ring once again. Artists must stop painting immediately, and return to Père Antoine Alley to display their piece for judging. Frames are allowed, but not required. *Framing will not be a consideration for judging.* 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place ribbons will be chosen, (with cash awards being \$150.00, \$100.00, and \$50.00 respectively).

Artwork can be left up for sale. If someone wants to purchase your painting, please direct them to the tent to make a purchase. Title, Artist name, medium, and price should be attached to any painting offered for sale. Sales will be made by NOAA, and a 30% commission will be kept for the association. Artists will be paid by check. During judging, and after the award presentation, participating artists may come to the registration tent for lunch. Art sale will be from 1:00 to 4:30. *Artists must pick up easels and any unsold paintings by 4:30. Artwork cannot be held by NOAA volunteers.*
